Re: Access to Screen Actors Guild Premises Prohibited

Dear Ms. Tull,

Please be advised that due to your ongoing pattern of inappropriate and disruptive behavior at Screen Actors Guild ("SAG") meetings and events, you are no longer permitted to visit SAG premises or attend SAG meetings, events, or functions in-person. This prohibition includes events at SAG headquarters in Los Angeles, any SAG division or branch office, or SAG Conservatory events at the AFI Campus located at 2021 N. Western Ave., Hollywood, California.

Screen Actors Guild will continue to provide all core services to you as a union member, including, but not limited to, enforcement of all terms and conditions of any SAG collective bargaining agreement that you work under. Business you may need to conduct with the union should be conducted by telephone, fax, online, by email, or by written correspondence. You may only enter our premises by advance appointment confirmed in writing by our Legal Department, or by specific individual invitation addressed to you in writing by our Legal Department. No general notice you receive of upcoming SAG meetings or events by virtue of your membership in the Guild, nor any RSVP or acceptance thereof by you constitutes such an invitation. You will be notified in writing by our Legal Department at such time as this prohibition ends.

Please take note that California Penal Code §602 prohibits unauthorized and unwelcome visits to private property. Should you attempt to make unauthorized visits to our premises, SAG will be forced to involve appropriate law enforcement agencies.

Nothing in this communication should be construed as a full and complete statement of the facts regarding this situation or a waiver of any of SAG's rights or remedies, all of which are expressly reserved.

Accordingly, you are prohibited from attending the Los Angeles Local SAG Awards Viewing Party on January 30, 2016.

This shall serve as a reminder that you are expressly forbidden to present yourself on SAG-AFTRA's premises or at SAG-AFTRA events other than pursuant to a written notification from SAG-AFTRA's Legal Department authorizing your presence.

Please take note that California Penal Code §602 prohibits trespassing. Should you attempt to make unauthorized visits to our premises or events in the future, SAG-AFTRA will not hesitate to involve the appropriate law enforcement agency.

However, you are not permitted to visit SAG-AFTRA premises or attend SAG-AFTRA meetings, events, or functions in-person. Accordingly, you are not permitted to attend SAG-AFTRA local board meetings as an observer at this time. You will be notified in writing by our Legal Department at such time as this prohibition ends.
